A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget for the United States Department of Agriculture for the Rural Community Development Initiative.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of Agriculture in the amount of \$152,492 to assist the Choctaw Nation in undertaking projects related to housing, community facilities, or community and economic development in rural areas, and


WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$152,492 with a required 50% match of tribal funds in the amount of \$153,102, and


WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Agriculture will assist the Choctaw Nation in providing support services and comprehensive referral to Tribal and community resources for Tribal members' entrepreneurial goals.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds for the United States Department of Agriculture for the Rural Community Development Initiative.
