


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation Environmental Office desires to operate and implement the General Assistance
Program and Water Quality Management Program.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited
as approval for the FY15 budget for the Choctaw Nation Environmental Office Performance Partnership Grant
Grant Agreement #00F88501 for the amount of \$197,526.00 under the conditions described herein.
