
TO APPROVE THE FY15 BUDGET OF THE CHOCTAW NATION ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICE




THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval for the FY15 budget for the Choctaw Nation Environmental Office Hazardous Waste Management Grant, Grant Agreement #00F93901 for the amount of \$99,354.00 under the conditions described herein.
