TO APPROVE application to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for the Environmental Justice Small Grants Program.


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to help build the capacity of communities to understand and address exposure to multiple environmental harms and risks, and


WHEREAS, funds from the United States Environmental Protection Agency will assist the Choctaw Nation in educating youth, school groups, elders, civic groups, etc., on the effects of litter while providing hands-on opportunities to clean up area waterways and other areas.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for the Environmental Justice Small Grants Program.
