IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

THOMAS WILLISTON INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

**TO APPROVE** the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma's disposal of a four bedroom house and land referred to as the Gifford Property which was obtained by legal settlement located in Creek County.

**WHEREAS**, the legal description is as follows:


Lot seventeen (17), Block four (4) in AMENDED PLAT OF MANNFORD BY THE LAKE, a subdivision to town of Mannford, Creek County, State of Oklahoma. Physical address of 129 Lakeview Drive, Mannford, Oklahoma; currently valued for tax appraisal purposes at \$299,584 by the local appraisal district.

**WHEREAS**, the Choctaw Nation Fixed Assets Department in conjunction with the Choctaw Nation Property Department desires to dispose of said property valued by an independent fair market appraisal with the net proceeds from any sale being returned to the Nation's General Fund.

**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval for the Choctaw Nation Property Department to sale the above mentioned property under the conditions described herein.

CERTIFICATION


