TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Interior for the Indian Highway Safety Program – Child Passenger Safety Seat Program.


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to continue to implement traffic safety projects to reduce the high number of traffic crashes and the resulting fatalities, injuries, and property damage, and


WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Interior will assist the Choctaw Nation in the supply of car seats to Tribal members promoting injury prevention safety.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the United States Department of Interior for the Indian Highway Safety Program – Child Passenger Safety Seat Program.

CERTIFICATION
