TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Justice for the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation Tribal Youth Program: Project Hokli Nittak.


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to continue to provide direct intervention and prevention and control delinquency with juveniles, and


WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Justice will assist the Choctaw Nation with counseling, training, and materials for our youth.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the United States Department of Justice for the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation Tribal Youth Program: Project Hokli Nittak.

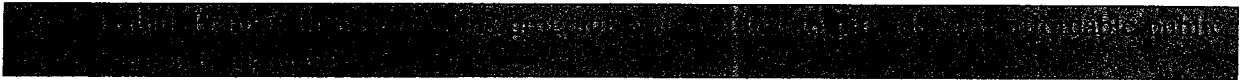
