IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration for the Hope for COVID: Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Emergency COVID-19 Grant (Emergency COVID).

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma has been awarded a grant by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration in the amount of \$500,000.

WHEREAS, the grant has been awarded for budget period April 20, 2020 through August 19, 2021, and is to provide training for healthcare professionals and first responders as well as a 24-hour mobile COVID-19 crisis response team to respond with psychiatric assessment, medication administration, and crisis stabilization. See Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, there is no required match; and

WHEREAS, grant funds will provide crisis intervention services, mental health and substance use disorder treatment, and other related recovery supports for individuals residing within the tribal jurisdiction, including children, adults and healthcare workers impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept Five Hundred Thousand Dollars from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Substance and Mental Health Services Administration, for the Hope for COVID: Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Emergency COVID-19 Grant.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Tribal Council that this bill be cited as approval of the budget for the Hope for COVID: Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Emergency COVID-19 Grant for budget period April 20, 2020 through August 19, 2021 as attached and marked as Exhibit A.


CERTIFICATION
