

TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR FUNDING FROM THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS TO CONSTRUCT NEW FORESTRY/FIRE OFFICE AND SHOP FACILITIES

**IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION
RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING BILL**

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the application for funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs to construct new forestry/fire office and shop facilities.

WHEREAS the Choctaw Nation Forestry/Fire Program has experience incremental growth over the past three decades, and the current facilities are no longer adequate; and,

WHEREAS the Bureau of Indian Affairs is making National Funding available on a competitive basis for fire facilities.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED that the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation approve this Bill to approve application of Facilities Funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs for a Forestry/Fire Office and Shop Facilities to be constructed in the Southeast ¼ of Section 3, Township 4 North, Range 21 East, Leflore County, Oklahoma. The site will be located on Trust lands North of the Talihina Independent Living facility and South of the Old Indian Hospital on the East side of the existing County road consisting of 5 acres more or less. This property is currently managed by the Forestry Program.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Speaker of the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, do hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of twelve (12) seats. Eight (8) members must be present to constitute a quorum.
