

**TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR THE DOMESTIC AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE
PREVENTION INITIATIVE – PROJECT HOMAKBI RIBBON**

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Three Continuation for the 2015 Domestic and Sexual Violence Prevention Initiative - Project Homakbi Ribbon.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of Health and Human Services for budget period September 30, 2017 through September 29, 2018 in the amount of \$210,000 to assist in expanding outreach and awareness of domestic and sexual violence among Native Americans; and


WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$210,000 with no required match; and


WHEREAS, funds for the Year Three Continuation for the 2015 Domestic and Sexual Violence Prevention Initiative - Project Homakbi Ribbon from the United States Department of Health and Human Services will assist the Choctaw Nation in expanding crisis intervention, counseling, advocacy, and behavioral health treatment, promoting community education for youth and adults, enhancing domestic and sexual violence intervention and prevention, and implementing trauma informed care.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds and budget from the United States Department of Health and Human Year Three Continuation for the 2015 Domestic and Sexual Violence Prevention Initiative - Project Homakbi Ribbon.
