

TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR THE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS FOR FIRST RESPONDERS

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget for the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Cooperative Agreement for First Responders – Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act – Addressing Opioid Overdose Deaths (AOOD) in Choctaw Nation.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of Health and Human Services for budget period September 30, 2017 to September 29, 2018 in the amount of \$250,000 to allow first responders and members of other key community sectors to administer a drug or device approved or cleared under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act for emergency treatment of known or suspected opioid overdose; and


WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$250,000 with no required match; and


WHEREAS, funds for the Cooperative Agreement for First Responders – Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act – AOOD in Choctaw Nation from the United States Department of Health and Human Services will assist the Choctaw Nation in training and equipping first responders with a life-saving antidote for opioid overdose along with resources for recovery and treatment centers.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds and budget for the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Cooperative Agreement for First Responders – Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act – AOOD in Choctaw Nation.
