

TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR THE YEAR FOUR OF FIVE CONTINUATION FOR THE TRIBAL MATERNAL, INFANT, AND EARLY CHILDHOOD HOME VISITING PROGRAM – CHAHTA INCHUKKA

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Administration for Children and Families (ACF) for the Year Four of Five Continuation for the Tribal Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program – Chahta Inchukka.

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approved the application to apply for the Year One of Chahta Inchukka in CB-65-16, funds and budget for Year One in CB-17-17, funds and budget for Year Two Continuation in CB-24-18, and funds and budget for Year Three Continuation in CB-141-18 and in CB-25-19 (Duplicate Council Bill).

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the “Nation”) has been awarded a grant by HHS for the budget period September 30, 2019, through September 29, 2020, in the amount of \$625,000 to assist in responding to the diverse needs of children and families in communities at risk and provide an opportunity to improve health and development outcomes; See Exhibit 1

WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$625,000 with no required match; and


WHEREAS, funds will provide high quality evidence-based home visiting services to promote improvements in maternal and prenatal, infant, and child health, reduce child maltreatment, improve parenting practices related to child development, improve family socio-economic status, and reduce incidence of injuries, crime, and domestic violence.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept six hundred twenty-five thousand dollars from the United States Department of Health and Human Services and to approve the budget for Year Four of Five Continuation of the Tribal Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program – Chahta Inchukka for the budget period September 30, 2019, through September 29, 2020.
