

**TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR YEAR TWO OF FIVE CONTINUATION FOR THE TRIBAL MATERNAL, INFANT, AND EARLY CHILDHOOD HOME VISITING PROGRAM – CHAHTA VLLA APELA**

**IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION**

**RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL**

**A COUNCIL BILL**

**TO APPROVE** the funds and budget for Year Two of Five Continuation from the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) for the Tribal Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program – Chahta Vlla Apela.

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council approved the application for Chahta Vlla Apela in CB-112-18 and Year One funds and budget for Year One in CB-33-19;

**WHEREAS**, the Choctaw Nation (the “Nation”) has been awarded a grant by HHS for budget period September 30, 2019, through September 29, 2020, in the amount of \$435,000 to assist in widespread planning, adoption, implementation, and sustainability of evidence-based maternal, infant, and early childhood home visiting program; See Exhibit 1


**WHEREAS**, the total federal budget is \$435,000 with no required match; and

**WHEREAS**, funds for Chahta Vlla Apela will assist the Nation in providing high quality, evidence-based home visiting services to promote outcomes as improvements in maternal and prenatal, infant, and child health, reduce child maltreatment, and improve parenting practices.

**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept four hundred thirty-five thousand dollars and to approve the budget from the United States Department of Health and Human Services for Year Two of Five Continuation for the Tribal Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program - Chahta Vlla Apela for the budget period September 30, 2019, through September 29, 2020.
