

TO APPROVE A HIGHWAY EASEMENT ON LAND HELD BY THE USA IN TRUST FOR THE CHOCTAW NATION OF OKLAHOMA, IN FAVOR OF THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, IN BRYAN COUNTY, OKLAHOMA

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE a Highway Easement in favor of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in Bryan County, Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, the Chief shall perform all duties pertaining to the Office of the Chief Executive. He shall sign official papers on behalf of the Nation, and;


WHEREAS, ODOT has proposed to construct and maintain a public highway and incidental utilities on land held USA in Trust for the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (Parcel 35-Perpetual Easement; Parcel 35.1-Temporary Drive; and Parcel 35.2-Temporary Construction) lying in part of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 7 South, Range 8 East, Bryan County, Oklahoma, more particularly described on the attached Survey Plat labeled Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the easement for Parcel 35 will be for a perpetual term, Parcel 35.1 will be for a Temporary Drive, and Parcel 35.2 will be for Temporary Construction. The Choctaw Nation has agreed to donate the property to ODOT.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval of the proposed highway easement in favor of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation, on land held by the USA in Trust for the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma in Bryan County, Oklahoma.


CERTIFICATION
