RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) for the Tribal Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program: Implementation and Expansion, from the Administration for Children and Families (ACF); CFDA 93.872.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to continue a coordinated approach by conducting coordinated community needs and readiness assessment of at-risk tribal communities through a collaborative process implementing high-quality, culturally relevant, evidence-based home visiting programs. Improving and enhancing infrastructure and capacity to implement, sustain, or expand home visiting programs. Engaging with tribal, local, and state early childhood program partners and other stakeholders to maximize the success of home visiting programs.


WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Health and Human Services will assist the Choctaw Nation by the support of a 5-year cooperative agreement between ACF and federally recognized Indian tribes.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Tribal Maternal, Infant, Early Childhood Home Visiting Program: Implementation and Expansion Grants.
