

TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR THE 2018 PLAY STREETS AGREEMENT

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health for the 2018 Play Streets Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been sub-awarded a grant by the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health for budget period June 1, 2018 through September 30, 2018 in the amount of \$1,500 to support administrative supplies, rental fees (e.g., inflatables), and programming equipment, such as sidewalk chalk, hula hoops, jump ropes, frisbees, basketballs, and soccer balls, to utilize at Play Street events;

WHEREAS, the total grant budget is \$1,500 with no required match; and

WHEREAS, funds for the 2018 Play Streets Agreement from the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health will assist the Choctaw Nation Health Services Authority to host youth focused events to encourage physical activity.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds and budget from the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health for the 2018 Play Streets Agreement.
