TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR THE YEAR THREE OF FIVE CONTINUATION  
COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR FIRST RESPONDERS

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget for the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) Year Three of Five Continuation Cooperative Agreement for First Responders – Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act-Addressing Opioid Overdose Deaths (hereinafter “AOOD”) in the Choctaw Nation.

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approved the funds and budget for Year One of the Agreement in CB-18-18 and funds and budget for Year Two of the Agreement in CB-47-19;

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the “Nation”) has been awarded a grant by HHS for budget period September 30, 2019 to September 29, 2020;

WHEREAS, the funds will allow first responders (and members of other key community sectors), to administer a drug or device for emergency treatment of known or suspected opioid overdose, as approved by the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act;


WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$250,000 with no required match; and


WHEREAS, funds for the AOOD from HHS will assist the Nation in training and equipping first responders with a life-saving antidote for opioid overdose along with resources for recovery and treatment centers.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds and budget from the United States Department of Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration for the Year Three of Five Continuation Cooperative Agreement for First Responders – Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act – AOOD in Choctaw Nation.
