

TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR THE TRIBAL WILDLIFE GRANT

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Department of Interior for the Tribal Wildlife Grant.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of the Interior (DOI) for budget period May 20, 2019 through December 31, 2020 in the amount of \$240,000 to develop or implement activities or programs that benefit wildlife and their habitat, including species of Native American cultural or traditional importance,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approved the application for the 2017 Tribal Wildlife Grant in CB-114-17;


WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$240,000 with no required match; and

WHEREAS, funds will assist the Nation in broadening and enhancing the management plan for the wildlife and fisheries on the Nation's wildlife unit, developing baseline survey data of the existing wildlife and fisheries, controlling predators that affect the natural reproduction of white tail deer and other species, and improving habitats through controlled burns and other processes.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds and budget from the United States Department of Interior for the Tribal Wildlife Grant.
