TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Justice for the Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Grant.


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to enhance or supplement existing Tribal Victim Services programs; and


WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Justice will assist the Choctaw Nation by supplementing legal advocacy and consultation for victims through contracted services and activities that emphasize healing and self-sufficiency for victims through support from Victim Advocates and certified trainers in focused topics.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for application to the United States Department of Justice for the Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Grant.

CERTIFICATION
