RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Justice for the Bureau of Justice Assistance Supporting Innovation: Field-Initiated Programs Grant.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to support tribal criminal justice practitioners to reduce violent crime, improve public safety, and combat the opioid epidemic; and

WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Justice will assist the Choctaw Nation in establishing a Tribal Prosecuting Attorney's Office and having the prosecuting attorney appointed as a Tribal Special Assistant U.S. Attorney, with the ability to prosecute federal cases.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for application to the United States Department of Justice for the Bureau of Justice Assistance Supporting Innovation: Field-Initiated Programs Grant.

CERTIFICATION
