RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Three of Five Continuation for the 2016 Native Youth Initiative for Leadership, Empowerment, and Development (I-LEAD) - Chahta Himmak Pila Pehlich (Choctaw Future Leaders).

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the budget period September 30, 2018, through September 29, 2019; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Nation to assist in implementing evidence-based strategies and best practices that will increase student engagement in school and learning, encourage cultural and self-identify exploration, increase self-confidence and leadership abilities, improve job and post-secondary school readiness, and further develop local capacity to support Native youth well-being and provide needed support; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Nation to approve the funds and budget awarded by a grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services and the matched funds from the Nation for Year Three of Five Continuation for the 2016 Native Youth Initiative for Leadership, Empowerment, and Development (I-LEAD) - Chahta Himmak Pila Pehlich (Choctaw Future Leaders).

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept the total federal funds granted of \$301,175 (with a required \$75,294 match of tribal funds) from the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Three of Five Continuation for the 2016 Native Youth Initiative for Leadership, Empowerment, and Development (I-LEAD) - Chahta Himmak Pila Pehlich (Choctaw Future Leaders).

CERTIFICATION
