TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR THE YEAR FOUR CONTINUATION OF THE 2015 NATIVE ASSET BUILDING INITIATIVE - CAB-NABI

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Four of Five Continuation of the 2015 Native Asset Building Initiative - CAB-NABI.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the budget period September 30, 2018, through September 29, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Nation to assist in enabling individuals and families with low incomes to become economically self-sufficient for the long-term by providing participants with access to special matched savings accounts called Individual Development Accounts (IDAs) in which qualified participants receive support from the federal grant and Choctaw Nation to encourage participants to save earned income for the purchase of a home, small business capitalization assets, or to receive a post-secondary education; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Nation to approve the funds and budget awarded by a grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services and the matched funds from the Nation for Year Four of Five Continuation of the 2015 Native Asset Building Initiative - CAB-NABI.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the total federal budget of \$51,466 (with a required \$92,151 match of in-kind contribution) from the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Four of Five Continuation of the 2015 Native Asset Building Initiative - CAB-NABI.
