RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Department of Education for the Year Five Continuation for the 2013 Native American Career and Technical Education Program (NACTEP).

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of Education for budget period October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018 in the amount of \$473,787 to equip tribal members with vital career and technical skills, and


WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$473,787 with no required match; and


WHEREAS, funds for the Year Five Continuation for the 2013 Native American Career and Technical Education Program (NACTEP) from the United States Department of Education will assist the Choctaw Nation in accomplishing the goal of providing American Indian individuals from economically disadvantaged families with high-quality career and technical education, focusing on science, technology, engineering, and math programs that result in an industry-recognized credential, certificate, or degree so participants are equipped to secure employment in high-growth, high demand occupations.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds and budget from the United States Department of Education for the Year Five Continuation for the 2013 Native American Career and Technical Education Program (NACTEP).

CERTIFICATION
