IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Department of Interior for the Child Passenger Safety Seat Program.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of Interior for budget period October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018 in the amount of \$1,575 to increase car seat usage and decrease accidents involving children who are not properly restrained; and


WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$1,575 with no required match; and


WHEREAS, funds for the Child Passenger Safety Seat Program from the United States Department of Interior will assist the Choctaw Nation in providing low-income families with a free child car seat, installation, training, and safety education.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds and budget from the United States Department of Interior for the Child Passenger Safety Seat Program.
