

TO RESCIND CB-92-06 AND AUTHORIZE AND APPROVE CROSS-DEPUTIZATION AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CHOCTAW NATION OF OKLAHOMA AND LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES OPERATING WITHIN THE CHOCTAW NATION OF OKLAHOMA

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO RESCIND CB-92-06 AND TO AUTHORIZE AND APPROVE cross-deputization agreements between the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma and law enforcement agencies operating within the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, Article 1 of Section VII of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Constitution") states that: "The Chief shall perform all duties appertaining to the office of Chief Executive. He shall sign official papers on behalf of the Nation. He shall take care that the laws be faithfully executed."

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Sections 4 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation"), the Choctaw Tribal Council (the "Council") shall enact rule and regulations consistent with the Constitution and for the general good of the Nation;

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2006, the Council passed CB-92-06, a bill "To Recommend Approval of a Cross-Deputization Agreement Between the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma and the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the State of Oklahoma, and the States Political Subdivisions and local Law Enforcement agencies in the Choctaw Nation." WHEREAS, the Nation now wishes to increase the number of cross-deputization agreements to include all law-enforcement agencies operating within the Nation;

WHEREAS, the Council now finds it is in the best interest of the Nation to rescind CB-92-06 and authorize and approve cross-deputization agreements with all law enforcement agencies operating within the Nation, pursuant to the execution of the cross-deputization agreements by the Chief of the Choctaw Nation or his or her designee.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as rescission of CB-92-06, attached as Exhibit A, effective immediately.


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, that this Bill be cited as authorization for the Chief of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma or his/her designee, to enter into cross-deputization agreements with all law-enforcement agencies operating within the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, that this Bill be cited as approval of any and all existing cross-deputization agreements between law-enforcement agencies operating within the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma and the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma.


CERTIFICATION

Purpose/Need of Council Bill: The purpose of this bill is the rescind CB-92-06, a bill that authorized the Nation to enter into certain cross-deputization agreements. The Nation now wishes to enter into more cross-deputization agreements not listed on CB-92-06. To do this, the Nation wishes to pass this bill that allows and approves the Chief and/or his/her designee to enter into cross-deputization agreements with all law enforcement agencies operating within the Nation. This bill also authorizes and approves any and all cross-deputization already in place.
