RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget from the United States Department of Education for the Year Two of Five Continuation for the Indian Education Discretionary Grants Program – Professional Development Grants Program (Teach2Reach).

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (the "Nation") has been awarded a grant by the U.S. Department of Education (ED) Indian Education Discretionary Grants Program-Professional Development Grants Program (Teach2Reach), for budget period October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Teach2Reach grant provides training to Native Americans to become teachers and administrators;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Council") approved the funds and budget for Year One of Teach2Reach in CB-50-19;

WHEREAS, the Nation was awarded \$321,909 for the Year Two of Five Continuation for the Teach2Reach Grant. See Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the Nation has \$168,548.00 in remaining funds from Year One of the Teach2Reach Grant;

WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$321,909 from Year Two of Five and \$168,548 from Year One of Five for a total budget of \$490,367, with no required match; and

WHEREAS, funds for Teach2Reach will assist the Nation in prioritizing pre-service to teachers to achieve their degrees and certifications.

WHEREAS, the Council finds it is in the best interest of the Nation to approve the funds for Year Two of Five Continuation, Year One of Five carry-over funds, and the total budget for the Indian Education Discretionary Grants Program-Professional Development Grants Program (Teach2Reach).

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to accept Three Hundred Twenty One Thousand Nine Hundred Nine Dollars (\$321,909) from the United States Department of Education, Discretionary Grants Program-Professional Development Grants Program (Teach2Reach), for budget period October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, that this bill be cited as approval of One Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand Five Hundred Forty Eight Dollars (\$168,548) of funds from the Year One of Education to be carried over for a total budget of Four Hundred Ninety Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Seven Dollars (\$490,367.00), and to approve the budget for Year Two of Five Continuation for the Indian Education Discretionary Grants Program – Professional Development Grant Program for budget period October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020.
