RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Justice (DOJ) for the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitations (CTAS) Purpose Area #1 – Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Tribal Resources Hiring and Equipment/Training Grant.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation (“Nation”) realizes the need to continue a coordinated approach by providing Tribal law enforcement with equipment and training for safer communities;

WHEREAS, the Nation is eligible to receive up to \$800,000 for the purchase of equipment and vehicles from DOJ; and

WHEREAS, funds from DOJ will assist the Nation by allowing for the purchase of equipment and vehicles needed to provide effective and thorough community policing in the 10 ½ counties of the Choctaw Nation.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as Approval for Application to the United States Department of Justice for the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitations Purpose Area #1 - COPS Tribal Resources Hiring and Equipment/Training Grant.
