A COUNCIL BILL

**TO APPROVE** application to the United States Department of Justice (DOJ) for the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitations (CTAS) Purpose Area #3 - Tribal Justice Systems Grant.

**WHEREAS**, the Choctaw Nation (“Nation”) realizes the need to develop, support, and enhance adult and juvenile tribal justice systems and the prevention of violent crimes, and crimes related to opioid, alcohol, and other substance abuse;

**WHEREAS**, funds from DOJ will assist the Nation in developing, enhancing, and continuing the tribal justice system to prevent crimes related to opioid, alcohol, and other substance abuse, and provide meaningful access to alternatives and treatment of substance abuse; and


**WHEREAS**, funds for the 2019 Tribal Justice System Infrastructure Program (CTAS #4) from DOJ will assist the Nation in establishing a tribal drug court.


**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for application to the United States Department of Justice for the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitations (CTAS) Purpose Area #3 – Tribal Justice Systems.
