

**TO RESCIND CB-51-20 AND APPROVE THE SALE OF THE MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING MACHINE
(SERIALNUMBER R1050) LOCATED IN THE TALIHINA HOSPITAL**

**IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION RONALD PERRY
INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL**

A COUNCIL BILL

TO RESCIND CB-51-20, a Council Bill approving the sale of the Magnetic Resonance Imaging Machine (Serial Number R1050) for Ten Thousand Dollars, and approving the sale of the Magnet Resonance Imaging Machine (Serial Number R1050) for a new sale price of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Section 6 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the " Nation"), the Choctaw Tribal Council (the " Council") shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition and management of tribal property;

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Health Service Authority (CNHSA) has purchased and installed for use a new Magnetic Resonance Imaging Machine (the " New MRI") at the hospital in Talihina, Oklahoma (the "Hospital");

WHEREAS, the New MRI was purchased to replace the older model MRI machine (Serial Number R1050) (the " Old MRI"), located at the Hospital;

WHEREAS, the old MRI was at the end of life and failed to meet current standards;

WHEREAS, the cost to refurbish the Old MRI would exceed Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750, 000);

WHEREAS, the CNHSA located a buyer, Huckleberry Medical, LLC (the "Buyer"), who purchased the Old MRI for Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10, 000. 00) (the "Previous Purchase Price");

WHEREAS, the Buyer agreed to tear down the modular building housing the Old MRI, move all associated equipment, and clean up the location as part of the purchase price, a cost estimated by CNHSA to be in excess of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00);

WHEREAS, the Council found it was in the best interest of the Nation to sell the Old MRI to Buyer and approved the sale of the Old MRI in CB-51-20 for the above-stated purchase price;

WHEREAS, since the passage of CB-51-20, the Buyer has informed CNHSA that the Old MRI was substantially larger than the estimate giving by CNHSA, costing the Buyer approximately Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) more in tear-down and transportation costs. The increased costs to Buyer included renting a larger crane and larger truck to transport the crane, and an additional permit for the increased carrying-load; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of fairness to Buyer, the Council finds it is appropriate to rescind CB-51-20, a bill that approved the sale of the Old MRI for Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), and now approve a new sale price of the Old MRI for Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500).


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval to rescind Council Bill CB-51-20.


BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, by the Tribal Council that this Bill be cited as approval of the sale of the Magnetic Resonance Imaging Machine, previously located at the hospital in Talihina, Oklahoma, to Huckleberry Medical, LLC for Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500).

TO RESCIND CB-51-20 AND APPROVE THE SALE OF THE MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING MACHINE (SERIALNUMBER R1050) LOCATED IN THE TALIHINA HOSPITAL

Purpose/Need of Council Bill: This bill rescinds CB-51-20, a bill that approved the sale of an old MRI to a buyer for \$10,000. The purchase price included transport, tear-down, and clean-up, the site housing the old MRI, a value over \$250,000. Since the passage of CB-51-20, the Buyer, Huckleberry Medical, LLC, has informed CNHSA, that the old MRI was substantially larger than what was estimated by CNHSA, costing buyer \$30,000 more than expected. The unexpected costs to buyer including replacing a crate and truck with a larger crane and truck to transport the MRI, and an additional permit for the increased load.

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the sale of the magnetic resonance imaging machine (serial number R1050) located in the hospital in Talihina, Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article IX, Sections 4 and 6 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation"), the Choctaw Tribal Council (the "Council") shall enact rule and regulations for the general good of the Nation, and for the administration and regulation of the affairs of the Nation, and shall make decisions pertaining to the acquisition, leasing, disposition and management of tribal property;

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Health Service Authority (CNHSA) has purchased, installed, and put in operation a new Magnetic Resonance Imaging Machine (the "New MRI");

WHEREAS, the New MRI was purchased to replace the previous MRI machine (Serial Number R1050) (the "Old MRI"), located on the northeast exterior of the CNHSA Hospital;

WHEREAS, the old MRI is at end of life, the image quality of the Old MRI fails to meet current standards, and the cost to refurbish the Old MRI would exceed \$750,000;

WHEREAS, the CNHSA has located a potential buyer (the "Buyer") who is willing to purchase the Old MRI for \$10,000.00;

WHEREAS, the purchase of the Old MRI includes Buyer tearing down the modular building, moving all associated equipment, and cleaning up the location;

WHEREAS, the Buyer has agreed to incur all cost of moving the Old MRI, saving the CNHSA in excess of \$250,000.00 in tear-down and moving costs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Council") finds it is in the best interest of the Nation to approve the sale of the Old MRI for \$10,000.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED, by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this bill be cited as approval of the sale and removal of the Magnetic Resonance Imaging Machine, Serial Number R1050, for \$10,000.


