INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the application for FY2021 funding through the Department of Health & Human Services for the Community Services Block Grant.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) is accepting applications for funding of the FY2021 Community Services Block Grant (the "CSBG");

WHEREAS, the CSBG is available to federally recognized tribes and supports projects that seek to lessen poverty in communities, address the needs of low-income individuals, including the homeless, migrants, and elders, and provide services and activities addressing employment, education, better use of available income, housing, nutrition, emergency services, and/or health;

WHEREAS, Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation") desires to coordinate between governmental and other social service programs to assure effective delivery of such services;

WHEREAS, the Nation will conduct activities designed to assist low-income participants with benefits to supplement and support services provided by other Tribal programs, or to provide services which might otherwise not be available through any other agency or source; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma find it is in the best interest of the Nation approve the application to HHS for the CSBG.


