

**A RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING THE HONORABLE JUDGE FREDERICK BOBB TO THE
CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF THE CHOCTAW NATION OF OKLAHOMA**

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL RESOLUTION

A COUNCIL RESOLUTION

TO APPROVE a Resolution reappointing the Honorable Judge Frederick Bobb to the Constitutional Court of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, Article XII, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Constitution") states that "The judicial authority of the Choctaw Nation shall be vested in a Tribal Court which shall consist of a three (3) member Court appointed by the Chief with the advice and consent of the Tribal Council."

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Constitution, three judges shall be appointed for a term of three-years and the terms shall be staggered;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution, the Chief of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (the "Nation") has selected Frederick Bobb for reappointment to the Constitutional Court of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it is in the best interest of the Nation to confirm Judge Frederick Bobb to the Constitutional Court of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it is in the best interest of the Nation to increase the annual salary of Judge Frederick Bobb to Thirty Two Thousand Dollars (\$32,000).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that this Resolution be cited as approval to confirm the reappointment of Judge Frederick Bobb to the Constitutional Court of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma for a three-year term, expiring on January 9, 2024.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council that this Resolution be cited as approval to increase the annual salary of Judge Frederick Bobb to Thirty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$32,000).


CERTIFICATION
