

TO APPROVE THE 2013-14 HEAD START POLICY AND PROCEDURE HANDBOOK

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

THOMAS WILLISTON INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE, the Choctaw Nation Head Start Program policy and procedures/content area plans and staff handbook for the employees.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Head Start is an education program operated by the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma contracted through the Office of Head Start American Indian-Alaska Native Program Branch under the Department of Health and Human Services, and

WHEREAS, to approve policy and procedures/content area plans and employee staff handbook must be approved by the Tribal Council and Chief in order to be binding.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY The Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval for the FY 2013-2014 Head Start Program policy and procedures/content area plans and staff handbook.

CERTIFICATION
