TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Transitional Living Program and Maternity Group Homes.


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to provide runaways and homeless youth an alternative to law enforcement, child welfare, mental health, and juvenile justice systems, and

WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Health and Human Services will assist the Choctaw Nation in increasing young people's safety, well-being, and self-sufficiency, and to help them build permanent connections with caring adults, with the goal of helping young people who are homeless make a successful transition to self-sufficient living.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Transitional Living Program and Maternity Group Homes.


CERTIFICATION
