

TO APPROVE THE RESCISSION OF CB-30-2005

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

THOMAS WILLISTON INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the rescission of CB-30-2005 a Council Bill to Establish Guidelines and Policies Relating to Tribal Lands and Buildings.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma is a federally recognized Indian nation, and

WHEREAS, The Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma has exercised the sovereign rights of self-government on behalf of the Choctaw people and properties, and

WHEREAS, CB-30-2005 called for the establishment of guidelines and policies relating to tribal lands and buildings, and

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma has determined that it is not in the best interest of the Tribe to continue to maintain the guidelines and policies relating to tribal land and buildings as established in CB-30-2005.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this act be cited as approval for Council Bill CB-30-2005 to be rescinded.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as speaker of the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, do hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of twelve (12) seats. Eight (8) members must be present to constitute a quorum. I further certify that twelve (12) members answered roll call and that a quorum was present at the Regular Session of the Tribal Council at Tuskahoma, Oklahoma on November 9, 2013. I further certify that the foregoing Council Bill CB- 27 -14 was adopted at such meeting by the affirmative vote of twelve (12) members, zero (0) negative votes, and zero (0) abstaining.
