TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of the Interior for the Tribal Climate Change Adaptation Grant Program.


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to provide training on the challenges from rapidly changing climatic conditions that are impacting Tribes, and

WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of the Interior will assist the Choctaw Nation in hosting a short series of trainings for tribal representatives to gain skills needed to guide a tribal government level climate adaptation plan.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the United States Department of the Interior for the Tribal Climate Change Adaptation Grant Program.


CERTIFICATION
