

**TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR CHAHTA VLLA APELA**

**IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION**

**RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL**

**A COUNCIL BILL**

**TO APPROVE** the funds and budget for the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Five Continuation for the 2012 Tribal Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Grant Program - Chahta Vlla Apela.

**WHEREAS**, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the United States Department of Health and Human Services for budget period September 30, 2016 to September 29, 2017 in the amount of \$531,000 to assist in widespread planning, adoption, implementation, and sustainability of evidence-based maternal, infant, and early childhood home visiting program; and

**WHEREAS**, the total federal budget is \$531,000 with no required match; and


**WHEREAS**, funds for the Year Five Continuation for the 2012 Tribal Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Grant Program - Chahta Vlla Apela from the United States Department of Health and Human Services will assist the Choctaw Nation in providing high-quality, evidence-based home visiting services to promote outcomes as improvements in maternal and prenatal, infant, and child health, reduce child maltreatment, improve parenting practices related to child development outcomes, improve family socio-economic status, and reduce incidence of injuries, crime, and domestic violence.


