TO APPROVE application to the First Nations Development Institute for the Native Agriculture and Food Systems Initiative Grant.


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to have access to healthy foods and without that access to healthy foods, a nutritious diet and good health are out of reach, and

WHEREAS, funds from the First Nations Development Institute will assist the Choctaw Nation in increasing access to fresh, healthy foods and improve the overall health and well-being of Native children and families and to help increase knowledge of and control over where food comes from and help increase knowledge of the linkages between food and Native cultures, and between families' income and entrepreneurially-related food ventures.




CERTIFICATION
