RONALD PERRY INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Justice for the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitations: Cops Tribal Resources Hiring and Equipment/Training Grant.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to continue a coordinated approach by providing Choctaw Nation Tribal law enforcement with equipment and training for safer communities; and

WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Justice will assist the Choctaw Nation by allowing for the purchase of equipment and vehicles needed to provide effective and thorough community policing in the 10 ½ counties of the Choctaw Nation.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for application to the United States Department of Justice for the Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitations: Cops Tribal Resources Hiring and Equipment/Training Grant.
