TO APPROVE A REAL ESTATE INVESTMENT IN THE NORTH TEXAS REGIONAL AIRPORT (NTRA) IN GRAYSON COUNTY, TEXAS ON BEHALF OF THE COMMEMORATIVE AIR FORCE (CAF)

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

THOMAS WILLISTON INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE a real estate investment in the North Texas Regional Airport (NTRA) in Grayson County, Texas (west of Denison, TX off of Hwy. 289) on behalf of the Commemorative Air Force (CAF).

WHEREAS, the Commemorative Air Force seeks to establish a new National Headquarters within the State of Texas, and

WHEREAS, the North Texas Regional Airport in Denison, Texas would offer an excellent advantage, market differentiator, and an added amenity for our Gaming and Tourism efforts due to its location and demographic synergy, and

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma realizes the need to increase tourism traffic and length of stay as a draw for its various business entities, more specifically to the Choctaw Casino and Resort, and

WHEREAS, a real estate investment with the Commemorative Air Force would position the Choctaw Nation as a stakeholder in Texas and help us benefit from the inevitable growth of the North Texas corridor


TIHEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited to approve a pledge of \$ (5) Five-Million dollars of asset ownership in various real estate options to help off-set the estimated \$ (20) Twenty-Million dollar investment of relocating the Commemorative Air Force National Headquarters from Midland, Texas to the North Texas Regional Airport in Denison, Texas.

CERTIFICATION
