WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma realizes the need to continue to support existing library operations and to maintain core library services, and


WHEREAS, funds from the Institute of Museum and Library Services will assist the Choctaw Nation by supporting opportunities for the students at Jones Academy to receive updated books, magazines, newspaper publications and multimedia software that will encourage reading thus improving student's reading skills and to provide the salary for a library staff member.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the Institute of Museum and Library Services for the Native American Library Services Basic Grant.
