ANTHONY DILLARD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Agriculture for the Distance Learning and Telemedicine Grant Program.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma realizes the need to provide access to education resources for tribal members, and

WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Agriculture will assist the Choctaw Nation in encouraging and improving distance learning services in rural areas through the use of telecommunications, computer networks, and related advanced technologies.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the United States Department of Agriculture for the Distance Learning and Telemedicine Grant Program.
