TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Now is the Time, Healthy Transitions: Improving Live Trajectories for Youth and Young Adults with, or at Risk for, Serious Mental Health Conditions.


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to improve access to treatment and support services for youth and young adults ages 16-25 that either have or at risk of developing a serious mental health condition or substance abuse disorder, and


WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Health and Human Services will assist the Choctaw Nation in increasing awareness, screening and detection, outreach and engagement, referrals to treatment, coordination of care and evidence-informed treatment to ensure our at-risk Native American youth and young adults in the tribal service area successfully transition into safe and productive adult roles and responsibilities.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Now is the Time, Healthy Transitions: Improving Live Trajectories for Youth and Young Adults with, or at Risk for, Serious Mental Health Conditions.
