A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Two Continuation for the 2015 Native Asset Building Initiative.


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma realizes the need to enable individuals and families with low incomes to become economically self-sufficient for the long-term by providing participants with access to special matched savings accounts called Individual Development Accounts (IDAs) in which qualified participants receive support from the federal grant and Choctaw Nation to encourage participants to save earned income for the purchase of a home, small business capitalization assets, or to receive a post-secondary education, and


WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Health and Human Services will assist the Choctaw Nation in its mission to provide these services to participants, the Choctaw Nation hereby agrees to commit eighty six thousand eight hundred and sixty two dollars (\$86,862) of in-kind contribution for the Native Asset Building Initiative grant.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Two Continuation for the 2015 Native Asset Building Initiative.
