

**TO APPROVE REQUESTING FEDERAL FUNDING FOR PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING, INCLUDING SURVEY, DESIGN, ENGINEERING, AND PRECONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES; BRIDGE REPLACEMENT: BRIDGE NUMBER 06274 IN LEFLORE COUNTY**

**IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION**

**ANTHONY DILLARD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL**

**A COUNCIL BILL**

**TO APPROVE**, the Chief of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, or his designee, to apply for federal funding to complete preliminary engineering, including survey, design engineering, and preconstruction activities associated with the replacement of Bridge Number 06274.

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council is committed to protecting and preserving the interests of the tribal membership, and

**WHEREAS**, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma has a Tribal Transportation Program Agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs and is authorized to perform preliminary engineering and associated activities on projects; and


**WHEREAS**, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Transportation Program has identified Bridge Number 06274 in LeFlore County, Oklahoma as a structurally deficient structure and a hazard to the traveling public; and


**WHEREAS**, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma Transportation Program desires to request federal funds in the amount of One-Hundred and Fifty-Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) to prepare the plans, specifications, and estimates, collectively known as a PS&E packet, as well as other associated preconstruction activities for the replacement of Bridge Number 06274.

**THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** that the Choctaw Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma authorizes and approves the Chief of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, or his designee, to apply for federal funding in the aforementioned amount and for the stated activities identified above.

**CERTIFICATION**
