A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the funds and budget for the 2014 First Nations Development Institute for the Native Youth and Culture Fund.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the First Nations Development Institute in the amount of \$18,150 to realize Native youth represent the future of Native communities and that their health and well-being determines the future health and well-being of our community overall and by investing in our youth and giving them a sense of place and tradition in the community, our community ensures that it will have bright and capable future leaders; and


WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$18,150 with a match of tribal funds in the amount of \$11,900; and


WHEREAS, funds from the First Nations Development Institute allows Native Youth to participate in a year-long series of activities that will improve their cultural knowledge (language, values, and practices), provide physical actions and nutrition education to inspire healthy lifestyles, and impart character-building/leadership skills along with other mentoring-- all through participation in stickball, which teaches Native lifeway while supporting family and tradition.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to accept and approve the funds for the 2014 First Nations Development Institute for the Native Youth and Culture Fund.
