

TO APPROVE APPLICATION FOR THE CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY SEAT PROGRAM

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

ANTHONY DILLARD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Interior for the Indian Highway Safety Program - Child Passenger Safety Seat Program.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma realizes the need to continue to implement traffic safety projects to reduce the high number of traffic fatalities and injuries, and

WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Interior will assist the Choctaw Nation in increasing car seat usage and decreasing accidents involving children who are not properly restrained by supplying car seats, car seat related supplies and safety education to qualifying Native American families.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the United States Department of Interior for the Indian Highway Safety Program - Child Passenger Safety Seat Program.
