IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

ANTHONY DILLARD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Two Continuation for the 2015 Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative - Project Path to Hope.

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma realizes the need to provide suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention resources for Native Americans, and

WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Health and Human Services will assist the Choctaw Nation in identifying and addressing suicide ideations, attempts, and contagions through the development and implementation of culturally appropriate and community relevant prevention, intervention, and postvention strategies by promoting positive youth development and family engagement through strategies to reduce risk factors for suicidal behavior.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the Year Two Continuation for the 2015 Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiative - Project Path to Hope.
