

TO APPROVE THE FUNDS AND BUDGET FOR MEDICAL RESERVE CORPS CHALLENGE AWARD

IN THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

ANTHONY DILLARD INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL BILL

A COUNCIL BILL

TO APPROVE the fiscal year 2016 funds and budget for the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) for the Medical Reserve Corps Challenge Award. Whereas, NACCHO has received a grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services (Grant # 1 HITEP150032-01-00, CFDA # 93.008)).

WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation has been awarded a grant by the National Association of County and City Health Officials in the amount of \$15,000 to develop and sustain a medical reserve corps unit to supplement existing local units and emergency response infrastructures; and


WHEREAS, the total federal budget is \$15,000 with no required match; and


WHEREAS, funds for the Medical Reserve Corps Challenge Award from the National Association of County and City Health Officials will assist the Choctaw Nation in identifying, training and sustaining a team of medical, health and tribal volunteers within the Choctaw Nation who will contribute their skills and expertise to health initiatives, emergency preparedness, response, and recovery efforts during times of need.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to accept and approve the fiscal year 2016 funds and budget for the National Association of County and City Health Officials for the Medical Reserve Corps Challenge Award.
