TO APPROVE application to the United States Department of Homeland Security for the Tribal Homeland Security Grant Program


WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation realizes the need to increase the ability to prevent, prepare for, protect against, and respond to acts of terrorism and reduce the overall security risk to Tribal members, and

WHEREAS, funds from the United States Department of Homeland Security will assist the Choctaw Nation by securing resources and training to mitigate, plan for, respond to, and recover from all threats and hazards specific to tribal communities.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Bill be cited as approval for application to the United States Department of Homeland Security for the Tribal Homeland Security Grant Program

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as speaker of the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, do hereby certify that the Tribal Council is composed of twelve (12) seats.
