WHEREAS, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma realizes the need to grow the Choctaw culture throughout future generations, and


WHEREAS, funds from the National Endowment for the Arts will assist the Choctaw Nation in creating an educational documentary film series showcasing Choctaw culture and heritage that displays the beauty and uniqueness of the Choctaw people.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Tribal Council of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma that this Act be cited as approval to make application to the National Endowment for the Arts for the NEA Art Works: Media Arts Grant.

CERTIFICATION
